

Graduate School of Education (GSE) Literacy and Numeracy test

The GSE internal literacy test is designed to give students feedback on their literacy skills, particularly those skills required for the classroom. The test provides students with information about their proficiency in a) spelling and b) writing skills.

The GSE internal numeracy test is designed as a diagnostic assessment to provide students feedback on the numeracy skills required for the classroom. The test provides students with information about a) Numbers and Algebra b) Measurements and Geometry and c) Statistics and Probability.

Details about test dates will be made available in the beginning of the semester.

Students may prepare for the test by brushing up on their spelling and reviewing their writing, particularly their essay writing.

Students are required to complete the literacy test prior to going out on professional practice. Inability to do so may affect their ability to go on professional practice.
