| 2. Make all possible arrangements for your permanent accommodation in Perth.<br><b>Very early applications need to be lodged for on-campus accommodation.</b>   | <input type="checkbox"/> |

| 7. Keep the emergency contact telephone number with you, in case you have difficulty with your pickup.<br><b>0429 902 455</b> or +61 429 902 455 from overseas.   | <input type="checkbox"/> |
| 8. Bring all letters, emails and receipts from the University with you.   | <input type="checkbox"/> |
| 9. Check your baggage is within the weight allowance for your airline. Remember to tag all your bags with your name and destination address.  | <input type="checkbox"/> |
| 10. If you are bringing in foodstuffs, pack them separately in a bag. This will make it easier for Customs checking. You <b>must</b> declare all foodstuffs.  | <input type="checkbox"/> |
| 11. If you are bringing A\$10,000 or more in foreign or Australian currency (including travellers cheques), you <b>must</b> declare it.   | <input type="checkbox"/> |
| 12. If you are bringing in electrical appliances, ensure that the appliances operate on 240 volts.  | <input type="checkbox"/> |
| 13. If you are bringing a computer, make sure you bring the receipt with you.   | <input type="checkbox"/> |
